FRIDAY 1<sup>st</sup> SEPTEMBER 2017

**The By Brook – Castle Combe to Box.** 7.5 hrs. 7 miles. Moderate. Start at 10.00 am at Selwyn Hall car park, Box. OS Map ST 824686. A linear walk, so car share to Castle Combe. Long Dean, Slaughterford villages and some hills. Please bring a picnic lunch. Not suitable for pushchairs. Leaders: John Walker and Keith Rawlings.

**Colerne Parish.** 3 hrs. 5 miles. Moderate. Start at 10.00 am at The Fox and Hounds Public House in Colerne, OS Map ST 818711. Park at pub or adjacent Constitutional Club. Bring a mid-morning munchie. Lunch available at pub. Not suitable for pushchairs. Leaders: Russell Harding and Sid Gould.

Follow one of the branches of river Avon to Luckington, then Littleton Drew, Burton Brook valley and By Brook to Castle Combe. Please bring a picnic lunch. Not suitable for pushchairs. **Walking the Line –** 4.5 hrs. 8 miles. Moderate. Start at 10.00 am. at Wellow Old Station car park (free) OS Map ST 735581.
