

Bitton Parish Walks

Welcome to the 2017 season of Bitton Parish, these are a series of Sunday afternoon walks around Bitton and Hanham Abbots.

All walks will start at 2.30pm, so please arrive early enough to be prepared to start walking at that time. Walking time is somewhere between 2.5 and 3 hours depending upon the speed of the group.

The walks are open to all ages but those under 16 years should be accompanied by a responsible adult.

If you bring a dog, you will be responsible for keeping it on a lead where appropriate ie along roads or in fields with animals - no matter how well behaved or trained it is.

The paths vary in condition, some may be muddy in certain weathers, all include stiles or gates and some go alongside rivers so care will be needed.

A circular riverside walk on both sides of the Avon, reasonably flat

The Ochre Trail, a gentle climb through the Golden Valley Nature Reserve

Sunday October 29th at 2.30pm meeting at Warmley Car Park

Webs Heath, Siston, some gentle climbs
