

# Bitton Parish Walks

Welcome to the 2017 season of Bitton Parish, these are a series of Sunday afternoon walks around Bitton and Hanham Abbots.

All walks will start at 2.30pm, so please arrive early enough to be prepared to start walking at that time. Walking time is somewhere between 2.5 and 3 hours depending upon the speed of the group. The walks are open to all ages but those under 16 years should be accompanied by a responsible adult.

If you bring a dog, you will be responsible for keeping it on a lead where appropriate ie along roads or in fields with animals - no matter how well behaved or trained it is.

The paths vary in condition, some may be muddy in certain weathers, all include stiles or gates and some go alongside rivers so care will be needed.

Sat Nav BS30 5RG

The Ochre Trail, a gentle climb through the Golden Valley Nature Reserve  
Red ochre was mined in Wick until the 1970s.

### **Sunday October 29<sup>th</sup> at 2.30pm meeting at Warmley Car Park**

Sat Nav BS15 4NF (car park is on the London Road)

Webs Heath, Siston, some gentle climbs

### **Sunday November 19<sup>th</sup> at 2pm NB Earlier start time, meeting at the layby near the Sir Bevil Grenville Monument on the Wick/Lansdown Road**

Sat Nav BA1 9DB. Do not go down the lane.

Reasonably flat walk.
